The intention is to start the weekend on the Saturday morning, and finish after lunch on Sunday afternoon. That will give us plenty of time to do a variety of activities. On the agenda is lots of games, walks, camp fires, singing, etc.

You will need to provide your own bedding (sleeping bag, duvet) with a carry mat, lilo, or camp bed, and also your own crockery and cutlery, but a full 'kit list' will be produced near the time. All the catering will be done centrally.

The site does have a shower and toilet block, a covered cooking area (with ovens and kitchen equipment) and a hut, so we will have a few mod cons!
