Collect of the Day

Lord, you have taught us that all our doings without love are nothing worth: send your Holy Spirit and pour into our hearts that most excellent gift of love, the true bond of peace and of all virtues, without which whoever lives is counted dead before you. Grant this for your only Son Jesus Christ's sake, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

First Reading **Job 38.1-11** This passage and today's Gospel remind us that wind and water are not under our control. God's power in the universe is set forth here in rhetorical questions. Only God creates and sustains the workings of all.

Second Reading **2 Corinthians 6.1-13** This letter reaches a climax, as Paul appeals to the Christians at Corinth to understand how kind and gentle he is for Christ's sake, despite the strong rebuke he has had to give them.

Gospel Reading **Mark 4.35-41** Mark has shown Jesus's power to heal the sick in mind and body. Now he reveals to us the divine authority which was enough to still the raging wind and turbulent sea.

Post Communion Prayer

Loving Father, we thank you for feeding us at the supper of your Son: sustain us with your Spirit, that we may serve you here on earth until our joy is complete in heaven, and we share in the eternal banquet with Jesus Christ our Lord.
