Collect of the Day

Merciful God, you have prepared for those who love you such good things as pass our understanding: pour into our hearts such love toward you that we, loving you in all things and above all things, may obtain your promises, which exceed all that we can desire; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

First Reading Deuteronomy 30.9-14

Moses set God's Law before the people not as a burden, but as a way to be followed with all their heart and soul. It was for them to chose this as a way of life.

Second Reading Colossians 1.1-14

The Gospel was preached in Colossae by Epaphras, and we have no record of Paul going there. But he writes to assure them of his prayers, and to call them to a true doctrine of Christ alone as Saviour.

Gospel Reading Luke 10.25-37

A lawyer's encounter with Jesus gives us the familiar parable of the good Samaritan - an unexpected lesson in neighbourliness.

BUILDING ON SUCCESS

Foreign Currency: unused, unwanted coins and notes from foreign holidays can be converted for BoS: just drop them in the collecting tin on the BoS table.

Your PCC welcomed and supported Fr Paul Collins licence to this benefice; considered proposals from Jon for Youth participation on the PCC and upgrading our Parish database. PCC received three tenders for the building development. We authorized the BoS fundraising group to proceed with trust and grant applications on these figures. They are higher than we and our Parish Architect expected, so we authorised him to enter negotiations with the contractor, and decided to invite more contractors to tender. PCC also discussed parish communications: this news sheet, websites, "News and Views" and "Perspectives".
